

A STRONG PLAN TO STOP CORRUPTION IN THE BUILDING SECTOR

Master Builders Australia, representing over 32,000 builders, has laid out the necessary federal government actions required to permanently remove criminal elements and bad actors from the building and construction industry.

MBA's six-point plan for the federal government, based on the findings of past royal commissions, investigations and court judgements:

1

The CFMEU Administration and its oversight must continue through to the full 5 years.

2

Whistleblowers must feel safe to call these criminals out.

3

Productivity destroying clauses in enterprise agreements must be banned.

4

Competition laws must be reformed to stop secondary boycotts and cartel like behaviour that is used for an industrial purpose.

5

Enhance a 'fit and proper person test' so bad actors don't come back to the construction industry or show up in other industries.

6

Establish an industry-specific compliance and enforcement agency with cross-jurisdictional policing, resourced appropriately with the necessary powers to enforce the law and target and eradicate corrupt and criminal behaviour.
